Creation Time in the Season of Pentecost

Dates: Five Sundays in the Season of Pentecost beginning with the Sunday after Labour Day and continuing to Thanksgiving Sunday.

Meaning of Name: Creation comes from the Latin *creare* and *creatio* meaning to "to create."

Liturgical Colour: Orange, which is a warn colour, associated with enthusiasm, creativity, fruitfulness, endurance, and strength as well as with sunrise and sunset, fall and harvest, and the changing seasons, nature's last burst of colour before winter.
